4.	Respondent is prohibited from contacting those protected on page 1, directly or indirectly, such as by telephone, letter, e-mail, social media, or through third party.
III.	THE COURT FURTHER ORDERS:
	Surrender Weapons: Respondent must immediately surrender any firearms, other dangerous weapons or concealed pistol licenses to law enforcement and not access, possess, have in their custody or control, purchase, receive, or attempt to purchase or receive any of those items.
	Vacate shared residence: Respondent must immediately vacate the shared residence. Respondent may take Respondent person's clothing, personal items needed during the duration
