- 1. Respondent is enjoined from harassing, abusing, threatening, using or attempting to use physical force or cause bodily injury to me and other protected persons;
- 2. Respondent is enjoined and restrained from disturbing the peace and well-being of those protected on page 1 or removing them from Guam;
- 3. Respondent is prohibited from coming within 500 feet of those protected on page 1, such as their residence, place of employment, and school;
- 4. Respondent is prohibited from contacting those protected on page 1, directly or indirectly, such as by telephone, letter, e-mail, social media, or through third party.
