WHEREAS, *I Maga'hågan Guåhan* has declared by Executive Order No. 2026-05 a special holiday closing all executive branch departments and agencies of the Government of Guam on Monday, July 20, 2026 – the day before the Liberation Day holiday on July 21, 2026 – to provide the people of Guam additional time to commemorate the liberation of Guam from enemy forces, to “reflect upon the sacrifices made for the freedom of our community, and celebrate the resilience and unity demonstrated by our people through hardships caused by war and natural disasters;” and

WHEREAS, to provide uniformity and equity throughout the Government of Guam, it is reasonable to likewise close the Judicial Branch and allow the dedicated employees of the Judiciary of Guam to similarly commemorate and celebrate this significant event in Guam’s history.

NOW, THEREFORE, by the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, I do **ORDER** that the Judicial Branch of the Government of Guam shall be closed and its employees excused from duty on Monday, July 20, 2026, except for magistrate hearings or any other emergency filings. Any filing due Monday, July 20, 2026, shall be deemed timely filed if filed on Wednesday, July 22, 2026.
